Kent Tennis Announces
Annual Awards Online in January





The Kent Tennis Annual Awards will be held Online via Zoom for the first time on Thursday 21 January at 7pm. The move was taken as the current climate does not allow for the usual Presentation Dinner format in 2021, so we are getting ourselves ready to announce the winners.

The shortlisted nominations were announced at our Annual General Meeting and on our Instagram page. 108 nominations were received, which is excellent considering the current climate. Five winners have been announced already, with Emma Raducanu, last year's LTA National Junior Player of the Year being announced as Kent's Player of the Year, following her successful rise up the WTA rankings to 333, winning two LTA Premier Singles titles in the summer and being selected for the Great Britain Federation Cup Team. Jack Pinnington Jones, having risen to number 35 in the ITF Junior World rankings this year, was announced as Kent's Junior Player of the Year.

The other winners announced at the AGM were Team of the Year - Kent Ladies Winter County Cup Team, who have been National Champions for 4 consecutive years, Junior Team of the Year - Boys 18 & Under Team (who won Group 2 and promotion back to Group 1) and Kent Club of the Year (for 1 to 4 courts) are St John's (Tunbridge Wells) Tennis Club.
