

Kent Tennis – Parent Code of Conduct

Please respect the following when...

...your child is training

- Whilst they may have a desire to be successful, your child and those around them also play tennis for fun and enjoyment
- Make county training and county cup a priority, please ensure your child has the appropriate attendance and arrives on time

...your child is competing

- Acknowledge effort and fair play as well as success
- If your child has a score or line call dispute, do not get involved, please contact the official and respect their decision
- Your child's time on the match court is their opportunity to develop independence and problem solving, please leave them to learn
- Show respect to other players, their parents and officials

Team/training selections

- Respect the decision of the coach/captain in any selections, there are many factors that require their professional consideration, for example squad rotation, resting a player, doubles pairings etc. The captain will not be considering the individual ranking points for any player.
- If you wish to seek clarification or further information on a Kent Tennis selection, please do so in a polite manner
- Acknowledge the prestige of being selected for county training and/or county cup and ensure your child understands the same
