WHO WE ARE

Founded in 1890 we are the governing body (in conjunction with the LTA) for the promotion and delivery of all tennis and padel tennis across the county.

We have been at the centre of the sporting community for a very long time and our experience, innovative approach and enthusiasm has helped us take tennis forward across the generations. We have registered as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation and will be moving our activity into the new structure on 1st January 2024. This will enable us to reap the fundraising benefits that such a status offers.

WHAT WE DO

We strive to make tennis ever more inclusive, relevant and accessible as well as welcoming and enjoyable.

We work closely with the national governing body, the Lawn Tennis Association, supporting their considerable investment into parks and community facilities, which seeks to widen the base of the game and create a more diverse playing population.

OUR RECORD OF ACHIEVEMENT AND GROWTH

Kent Tennis is the home county of players such as Emma Radacanu, Virginia Wade and Annabel Croft. • We run 37 county teams across juniors, adults and seniors and won 21 national titles in 2022. • We have over 120 clubs and venues with over 45,000 active members and, in addition, schools in the county register with us too. • Our county-wide inter-club league has more than 600 team entries • We have 500 entrants in our county championships competition.

Improving playing facilities in parks and community venues, particularly in more disadvantaged areas and making these more accessible and user-friendly.


INCLUSION
