TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

The detailed tournament regulations are set out in Kent Tennis's Annual handbook. A summary is contained below.

ELIGIBILITY (Reg 2)

All competitors must be bona-fide members of clubs affiliated to Kent Tennis. Doubles partners need not necessarily be from the same club. Competitors must attain the minimum age during the year in which the competition commences. *(To qualify for an age category, a player must be of that age during the year the competition commences e.g. for the 60 year age category a player must be 60 the year the competition commences or 60 at any time during the year 1st January - 31st December).*

All competitors are responsible for ensuring the match is played within the time limit set. Initially that responsibility is with the player or pair with choice of ground. However, the opponent(s) "SHALL ALSO TAKE THE STEPS TO ENSURE THE MATCH IS PLAYED WITHIN THE TIME LIMIT". If for reasons other than bad weather the match is not played within the time limit, then both players shall be liable to be scratched from the event.

DATES (Reg 5 & 10)

If a date for playing the match cannot be agreed between the players, the match shall be played on the date by which the round is due to be completed.

NUMBER OF SETS

Matches are best of three sets, all three of which will follow the tie-break procedure at 6 games all, in line with the National Veterans' Events. In case of postponement the previous score holds good unless otherwise mutually agreed.

BALLS (Reg 7)

New balls of a make designated as within ITF specifications and (unless from a freshly opened pressurised container) of the current year shall be provided, except for the finals. These should be provided at the expense of the players with choice of ground, unless otherwise mutually agreed.
