DOUBLES

Popular as ever, the doubles often give rise to up a few questions. Here are the answers.

Subject to age restrictions, players may enter a maximum of TWO consecutive singles events, ONE same gender doubles event and ONE mixed doubles event. Please remember that players entering four events may be asked to play up to four matches a day. *Sign In for entry at the Control Desk.*

The Doubles deadlines are Tuesday 1pm for 14U & 18U and Tuesday 6pm for Open.

Doubles events take place from Wednesday 23rd August to Sunday 27th August.

In the event of bad weather or any other circumstances beyond our control, the Referee may alter the day or timings and/or the match scoring format. This may mean adopting abbreviated scoring.

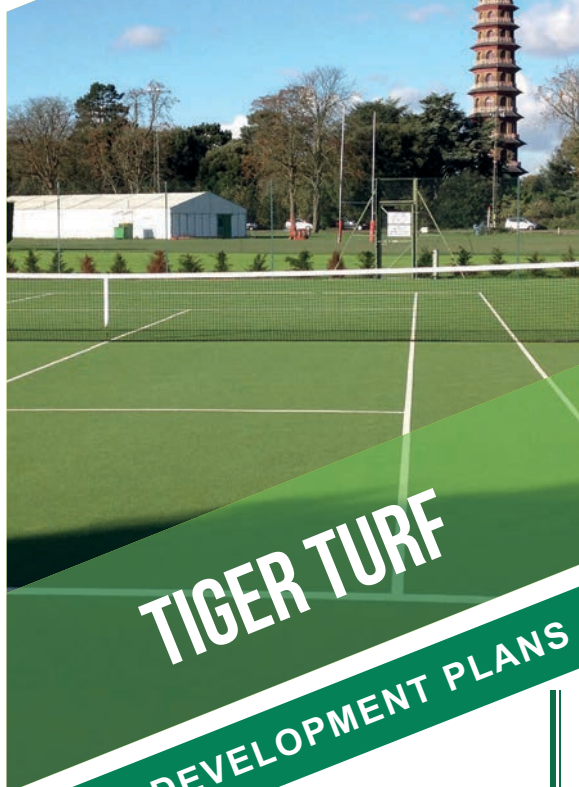

Junior County Cup 2023

This year, Kent's junior teams have all brilliantly represented the County. The stand out age-group are the 11Us. It isn't easily recalled the last time that two Kent teams of the same age, Boys and Girls, were in the National Final. A superb achievement and unsurprisingly both finals were against Surrey. Both matches were evenly poised after the singles at 2-2, with both ties going down to the doubles. The boys really stepped up and demonstrated the hard work that goes into the doubles preparation in county training, winning both doubles in straight sets and for the 3rd year running becoming National Champions. The 2012 year of birth Kent boys won the 9Us in 2021, the 10Us in 2022 and now the 11Us in 2023, very notable. The girls despite their best efforts lost both doubles in two close sets, finishing as Runner Up.

Our Congratulations and thanks go to all our captains, coaches, players and spectators, and our best wishes go to the 12U teams who are next to compete in September.

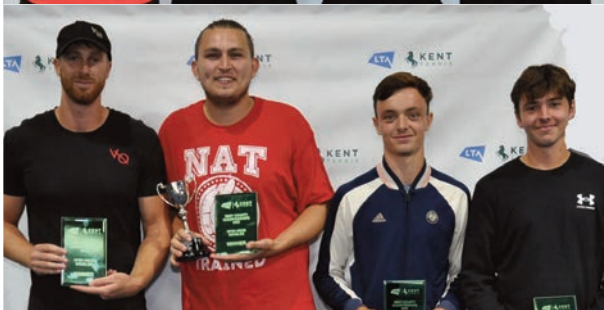
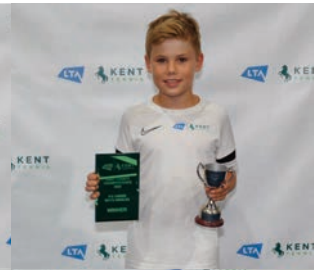
